Nebraska Wheat Growers Association Announces Educational Events

The second educational event will be held Friday, August 28, 2009 from 1:00 – 4:00 pm in the 2nd Floor Conference Room of the Mussehl Building located on the East Campus of the University of Nebraska in Lincoln. Although the event is free to Nebraska wheat producers, preregistration by August 28, 2009 is requested.
